Dear mums, dads & carers

Let me start by saying how heart-warming it is for me personally & for all of Stebon's staff & leaders to see so many smiling faces on the gates in the morning & children so clearly excited to be back at school. We love having you back. Every smile & every 'good morning' makes a real difference to us ... & that includes you grown-ups too! Covid-19 has not brought with it many advantages, but our closer & warmer relationship with you, parents, is certainly one.

This week, some of you have been frustrated by the difficulties you have had accessing tests. We completely understand your frustrations; it's hard to be told that you need to get a test & then for tests to be so difficult to book. We have passed on your concerns directly to the Department for Education & have been informed by government ministers that testing capacity will increase at the end of the month. Until then, I'm afraid, we need to expect long wait times. In the meantime, if you need to book a test, do keep trying. Most people get there in the end. We really appreciate your efforts.


