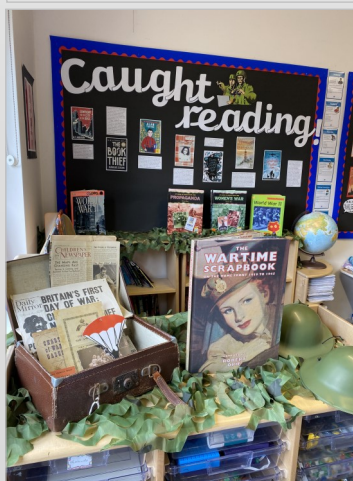


Year 5 used drama to understand the Greek Myth about Pandora's Box. They used still frames and narration to retell the story in their own words.
