Access to Stebon School

We are pleased to inform you that we will be able to access our Nursery gates from Monday 7th October 2019. Please note there will still be fencing in place, but the pavement will be accessible.

School Uniform

Our school uniform helps pupils to feel like a team and is compulsory from Nursery to Year 6. Our school uniform is a white shirt or polo shirt with a navy jumper, cardigan or sweatshirt, with the Stebon logo. Black, navy or grey trousers or skirts are all acceptable. Footwear is trainers or flat-heeled shoes in black.

For indoor PE, shorts and T-shirts in school colours are required. For outdoor PE, a warm top, jogging bottoms and trainers are needed.

Headscarves in school colours may be worn. Small studs and watches are the only jewellery allowed.
