Find out about our newest funder London City Airport who distribute over £40,000 of grants from a new Community Fund. The airport received over 140 applications since [announcing the Fund in May](#).

The first round of grants from London City Airport's £75,000 Community Fund have been awarded, with 16 charities and not-for-profit organisations from 10 different London boroughs receiving a lump sum.

In total, £40,000 worth of grants have been distributed, to provide a financial boost to local groups, such as youth clubs, mental health charities, community gardens, disability groups, and sports teams, including Dalmain Athletic Girls Football Club in Lewisham and the Kings Cross Steelers in Newham, London's inclusive Rugby Club.
