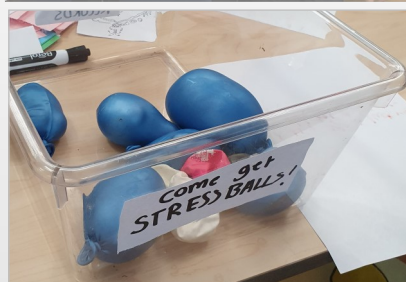

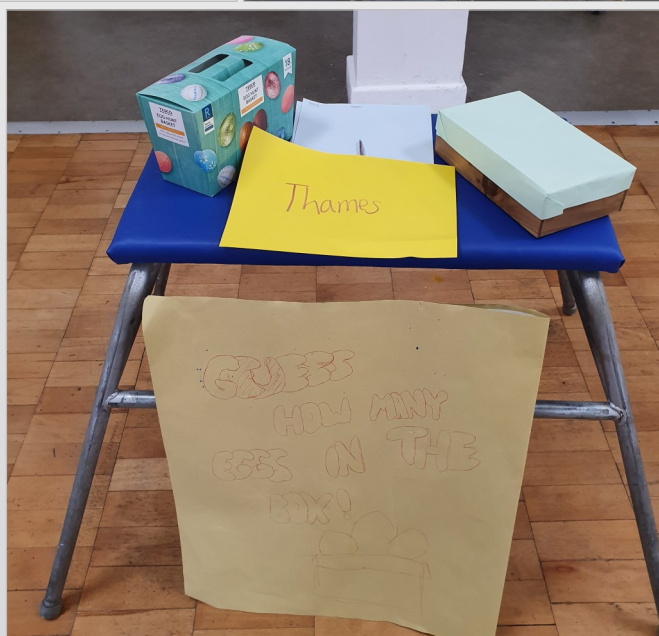
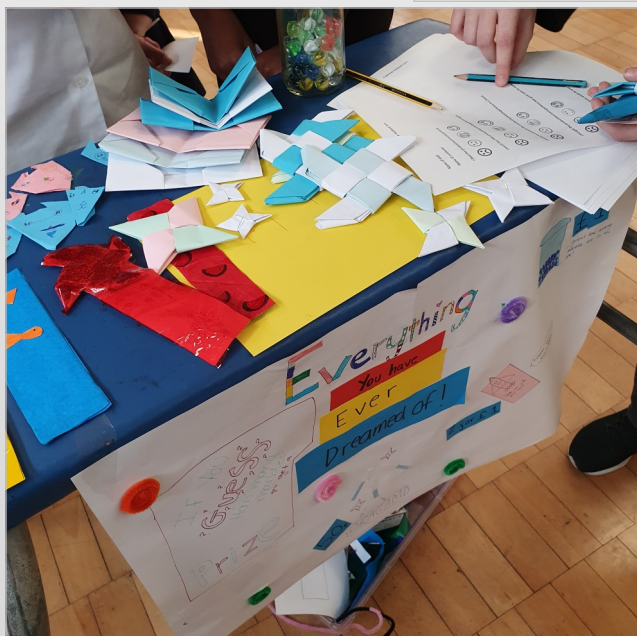
Shakespeare Schools Festivals

Today the Galaxy Explorers enjoyed a bug hunt to discover the mini beasts we share our peace garden with!



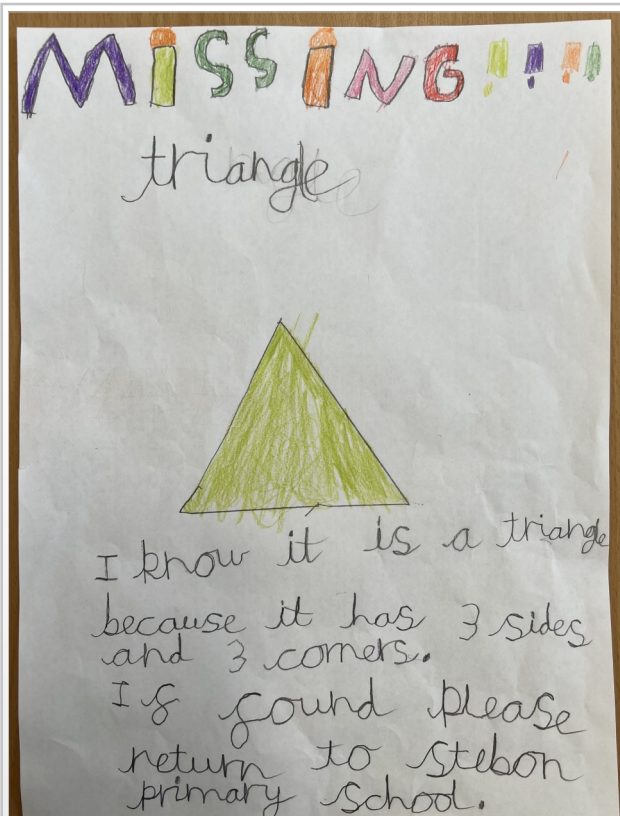

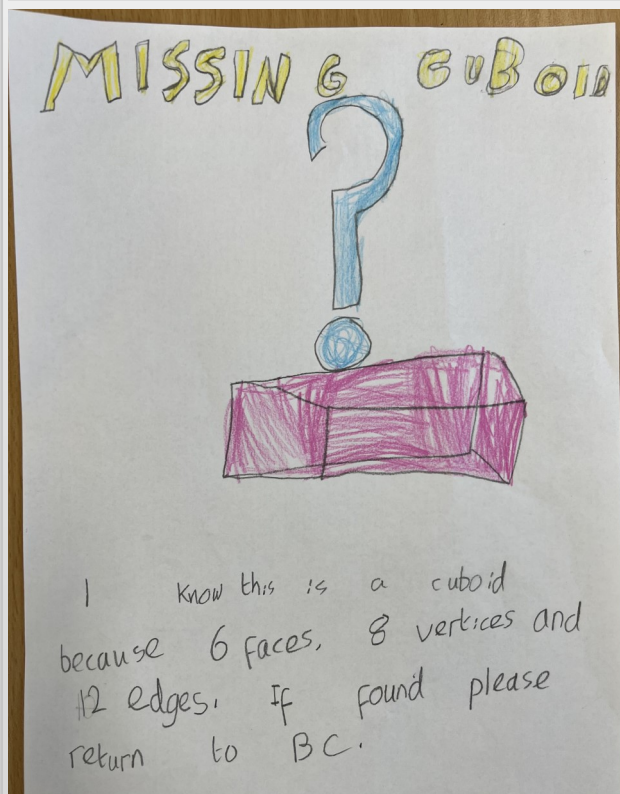

- Burgess Street - Replacement of current islands in carriageway with speed humps/speed tables and installation of soft landscaping

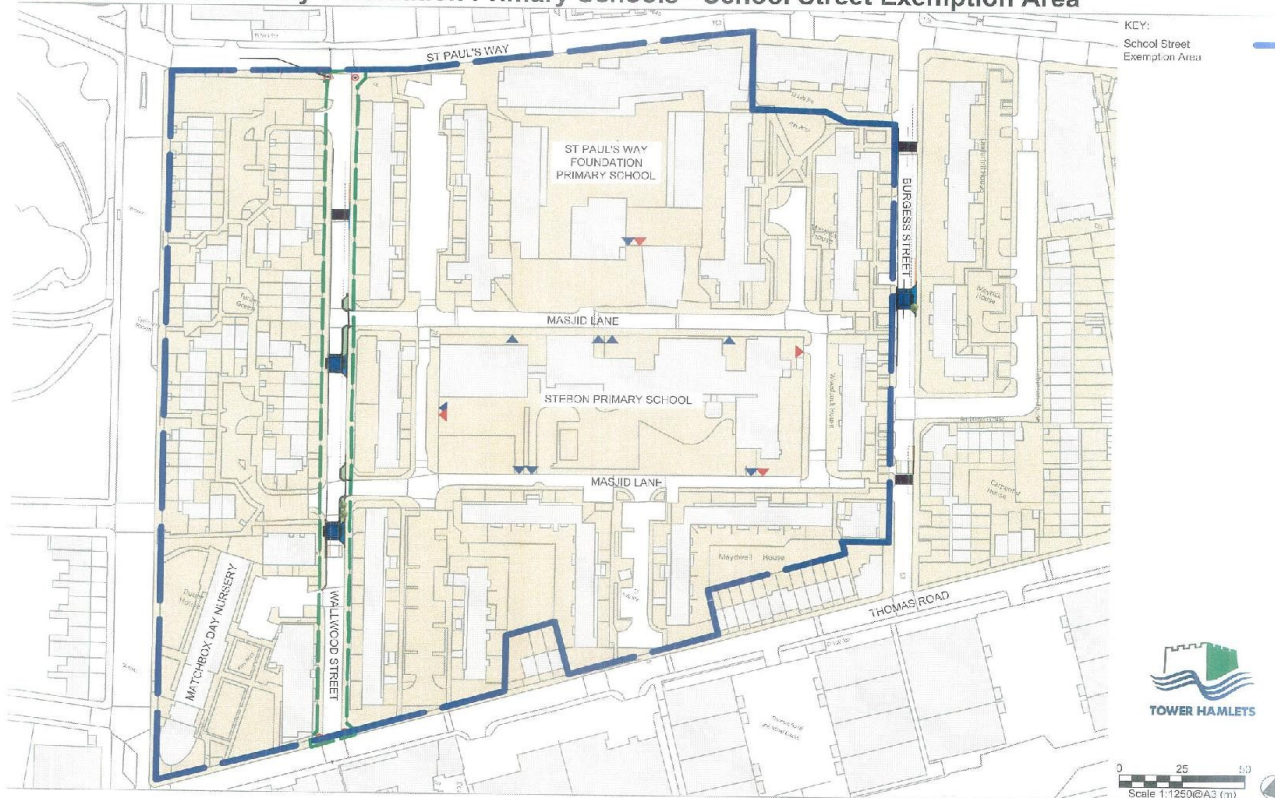
We apologise for any inconvenience, noise, or disruption these works may cause to you and would greatly appreciate your cooperation and patience during this time.

- * The guaranteed element of Pension Credit
