These works will be carried out at the following location:

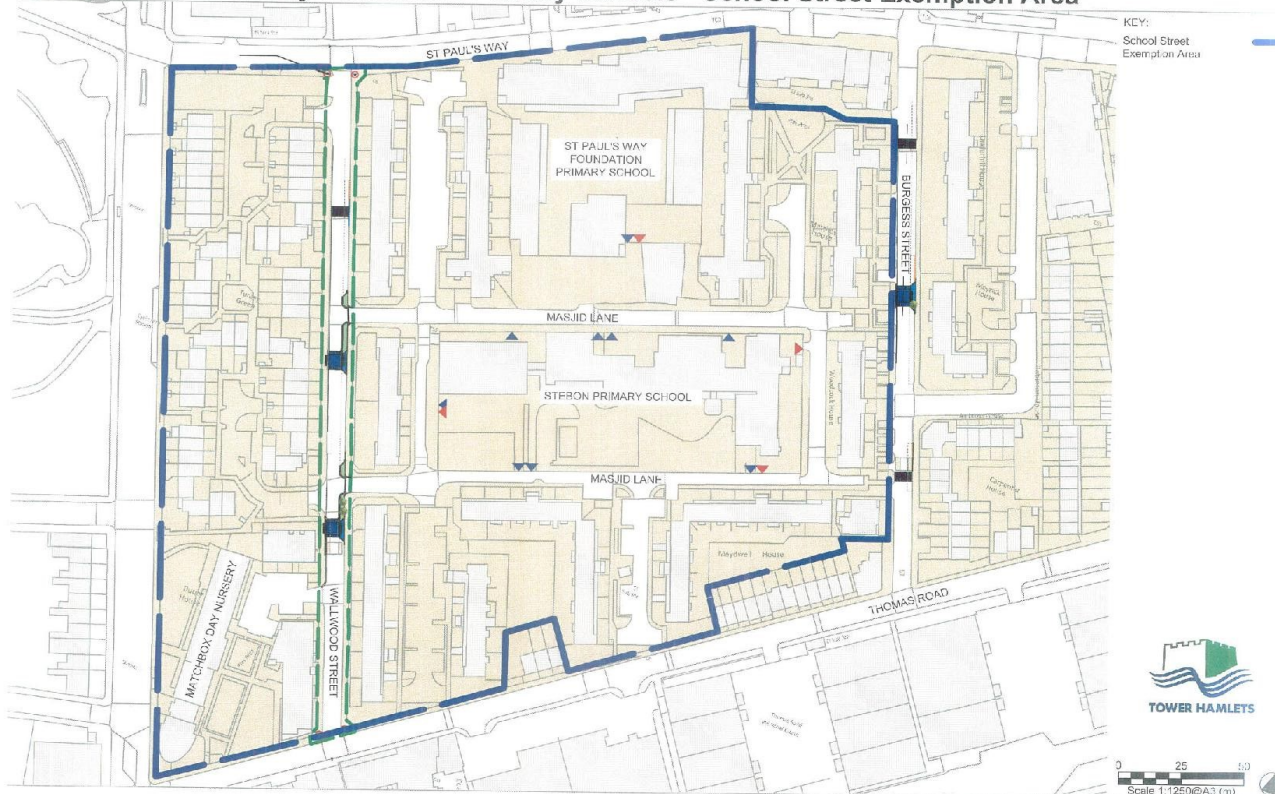
- Wallwood Street – Replacement of current islands in carriageway with speed humps/speed tables and installation of soft landscaping
