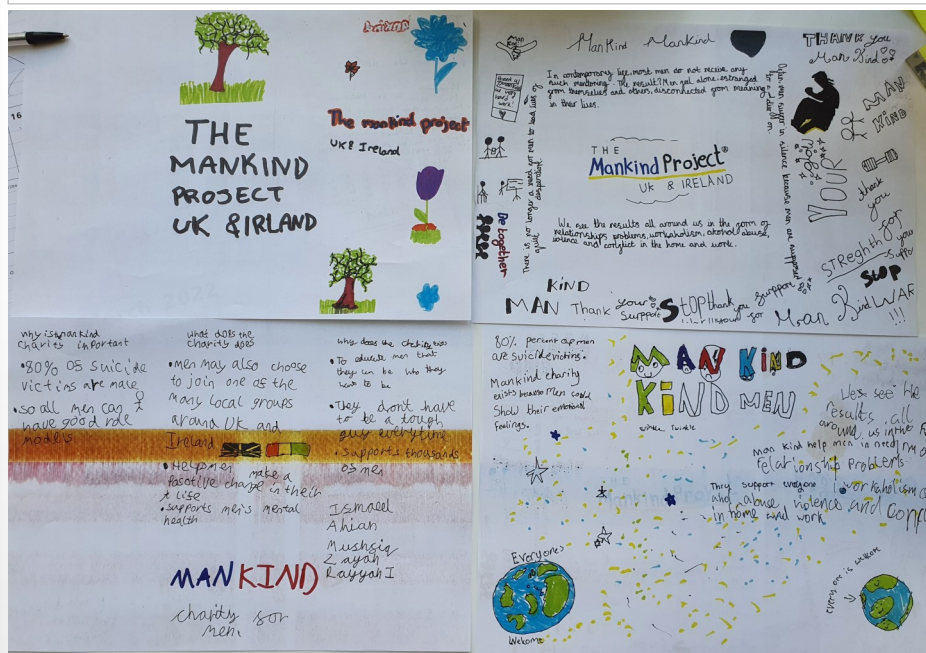




The last day of the Spring term is Friday 1st April 2022.

We're thrilled to announce that Stebon School have been awarded the Artsmark Gold Award in recognition of our fantastic arts provision!

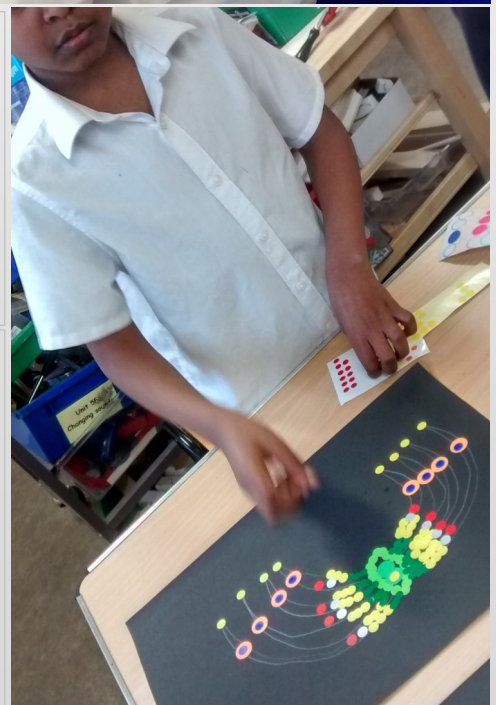
