To kick off our Rainforest Explorers topic for this term, Year 3 travelled all the way across to West London to experience the Rainforest Exhibit at Kew Gardens.

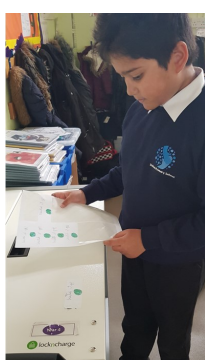

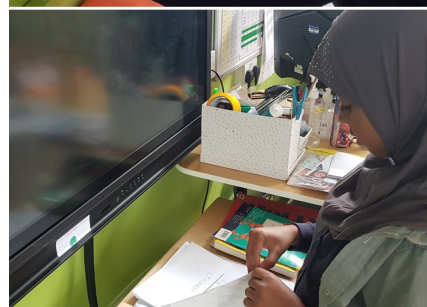


Eco-Protectors
