At home, pupils will count the plastic packaging they throw away for a week.



What you will learn: On this term's Level 1 course 'Understanding the Role of a Community Interpreter', explore public services, the role of the interpreter, boundaries, confidentiality, equality and diversity.

Online study: We provide live classes online with one of our highly respected tutors in a virtual classroom. You will need a stable internet connection and a tablet or laptop to take part. Please talk to us if your equipment is a barrier.

Cost: Courses are free.
