Please fill out the form linked below if you do **NOT** want your child to have their photo taken at school. Photos will not be shared outside of school.

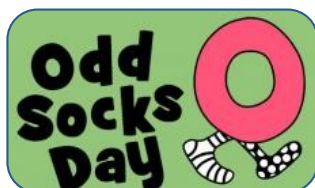

Staying warm and saving money this winter. The Energy Saving Trust's advice is to heat your home to between 18 and 21 degrees during the winter months. The World Health Organisation (WHO) advises that 18 degrees is the ideal temperature for well dressed people in their home and both organisations agree 18 degrees is the best for sleep. Each degree that you increase your thermostat can add an extra 10% to your bill so the difference between 18 degrees and 28 degrees is an increase of 100% So go on, stick on a thick jumper and a nice warm blanket before you turn your heating up an extra degree.
