Year 1 visited Bartlett Park for a nature walk. They had a lot of fun and came back to school with lots of leaves!











Saving energy whilst cooking! Here is a list of the most energy and efficient and cost effective ways to cook up a storm in your kitchen.




- 1. Microwave average cost 8p a day
- 2. Air fryer average cost 14p a day
- 3. Slow cooker average cost 16p a day
- 4. Gas cooker average cost 33p a day
- 5. Dual cooker average cost 72p a day
- 6. Electric cooker 87p a day
