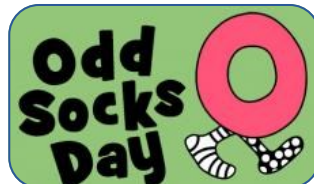

6. Electric cooker - 87p a day





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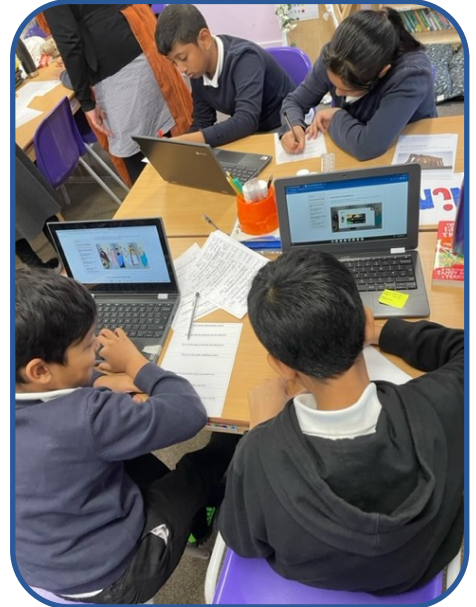
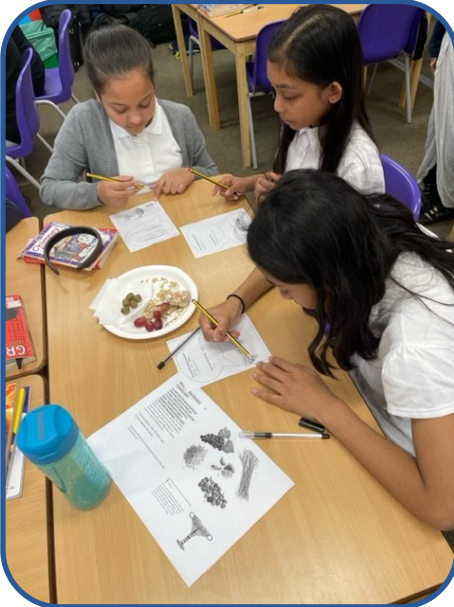
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Year 5 immersed themselves in Ancient Greek life. They used online sources, artefacts and objects to learn about their beliefs, food and clothes.

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Education & Childcare for 2 Year olds Exciting New Provision at Stebon School

Many 2 year old children are now able to access **15 hours of free childcare** per week in the UK from the term after their 2nd birthday.

- * Income Support

- * Income-related Employment and Support Allowance (ESA)
- * Universal Credit, & household income is £15,400 a year or less
- * Child tax credits, & household income is £16,190 a year or less
- * The guaranteed element of Pension Credit
- * The Working Tax Credit 4-week run on
