### **NEU** industrial action

As you may have heard, the National Education Union (NEU) has given notice for a series of national and regional strikes to take place over the next couple of months. For us in the London region, those dates are:

Wednesday 1 February (national strike)
Thursday 2 March (London regional strike))
Wednesday 15 and Thursday 16 March (national strikes)

Only teachers who are members of the NEU will be called upon to strike. All other staff will be at work as usual.

We will be taking steps to ensure that we can remain open for the maximum number of children on each of these days & will, of course, let you know about any changes in arrangements.

The Mile End Safer Neighbourhood Policing Team visited us to speak with Reception and Year 1 children. The children had lots of questions for the officers!








Bow Arts worked with three of our Explorers groups last term to make artworks to commemorate certain people and groups. The first of these has been installed in our playground!



We will also be running the same meeting after school on Monday afternoon at 3:45pm if you were unable to attend (or if you want to come again).


The Kitchen will be serving a themed menu on Tuesday 24 January to celebrate Chinese New Year!


