Members of the NEU across the country have voted to take further industrial action in the form of strikes. These are due to take place on **Thursday 27th April and Tuesday 2nd May**. Many of our teaching staff intend to strike on both days.

Just as on the previous strike days, our foremost consideration is the health & safety of the children in school. With this in mind, we have decided to put similar arrangements in place on both days, though there are some key differences:

On Thursday 27th April

- **The 2 year-old provision will be open as usual**
- **The nursery will be open for both morning and afternoon pupils**
- **Pupils in Y6 will also come to school**

- We will be inviting a number of other pupils in other year groups to be in school if there is a particular reason why they should be here e.g. children whose parents work for the NHS. If you believe your child should be invited to attend school, and you have not heard from us by the end of Tuesday 25th April, please contact the school office and let us know.

- **School will be closed for all other pupils.**

We have arranged for the kitchen to provide packed lunches for children who are eligible for free school. These packed lunches can be picked up from the school office from 12pm on Wednesday & Thursday. All children in school that day will receive a hot meal as usual.

We apologise for any inconvenience that this may cause you and we will update you about the strike on Tuesday 2nd May next week.

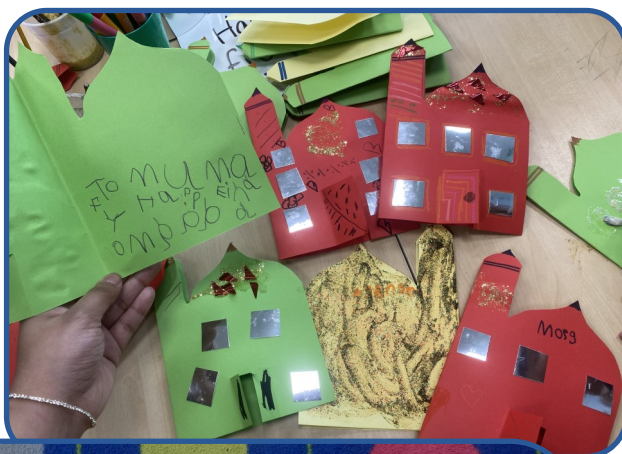
