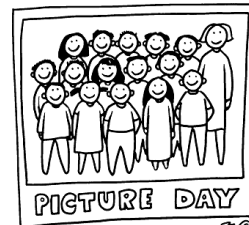
Class photos

NEU strikes: Wed 5th July & Fri 7th July 2023

Just as on the previous strike days, our foremost consideration is the health & safety of the children in school. With this in mind, we have decided to put similar arrangements in place on Wednesday & Friday:

- The 2 year-old provision will be open as usual.
- The nursery will also be open for both morning and afternoon pupils.
- We have invited a number of other pupils in other year groups to be in school if there is a particular reason why they should be here e.g. children whose parents work for the NHS. School will be closed for all other pupils.

The kitchen will provide packed lunches for children who are eligible for free school meals but who may not be in school on that day. This is the same arrangement as the previous strikes so you would have already been contacted. These packed lunches can be picked up from the school office from 12pm on both days. All children in school that day will receive a hot meal as usual.

The decision to close the school for any pupil is a difficult one to make and we understand that this might cause frustration. We trust, however, that you understand we are making the decision in what we believe to be the best interests of your children & we apologise for any inconvenience that this may cause you.

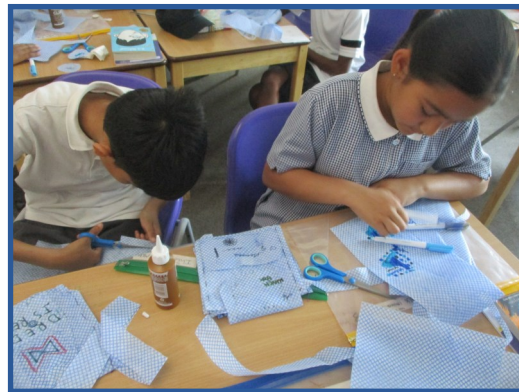

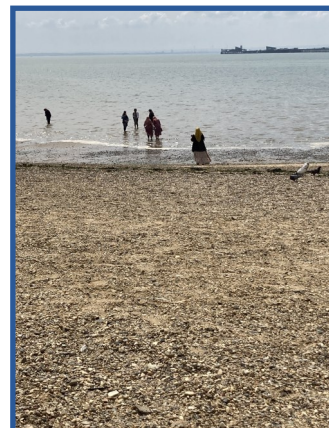


Here is Y6 David Attenborough class on their trip this week to the Ben Kinsella workshop on knife crime.

Green Butterfly Craft

using nature's own materials



Green Craft

Visit your local park and collect leaves, flowers, twigs, sticks or any natural materials left on the ground or grass, (please do not pick flowers or leaves from the tree). To make your green butterfly, you will need four leaves, one stick and a long stem. Place the stick on the table and position the four leaves either side of the stick, (refer to the photo on the left). Then, wrap the leaves and stick together using the stem.

Try making your own insects using natural materials.

Go on a Bug Safari

Let's go on a Bug Safari...

Enjoy exploring the natural environment and develop young minds. Visit your garden, plan a trip to the local park, or woodland park. Take a shovel, magnifying glass, or see-through pots.

Search for mini beasts everywhere- under logs and rocks, beneath pots, on leaves, in the grass and on the walls. Just remember to be very gentle to avoid hurting these tiny creatures. I wonder what bugs you will discover on your safari...

Look out for a wolf (spider), dragon (fly) or tiger (moth) in your green patch?



Homemade fruit Ice lollies

As the weather is getting warmer enjoy making your own ice lollies at home.

Ingredients:

1 banana (slice into small pieces)
4 strawberries (slice into small pieces)
Handful of blueberries
240ml of apple juice
Ice lolly moulds

Method:

1. Place the fruits inside the ice lolly moulds, until nearly full.
2. Pour the apple juice inside the mould, then carefully insert the lollypop stick inside.
3. Place the moulds in the freezer for 6 hours or overnight. Enjoy!
