


The children in the Friday art club unleash their creativity by crafting their own characters and animals using only pencils and leaves. Look at these astounding results!

# Starting Secondary school in September 2024

If you live in Tower Hamlets and your child is in Year 6 (born between 1 September 2012 and 31 August 2013) you will need to make an online application via <u>eadmissions portal</u> for them to transfer to secondary school in September 2024.

The closing date for making applications is Tuesday 31st October 2023

The Ready for <u>Secondary School in Tower Hamlets</u> booklet contains all the information you need on applying, including a step by step guide to making your online application.
