Here we are at the end of a long autumn term and the winter holiday is upon us. And what a term it's been! We've had Y6 stretching their wings on their residential, and trips to farms, churches and the Tower of London - to name a few - and wonderful performances by Y5 (remember the amazing 'Jungle Book'?), and the cutest winter show by Y1, and reception! What a joy to see so many of you there to support your children!

In the message I wrote to you in the newsletter at the end of the summer term, I was not yet at liberty to share our outstanding OFSTED result. Happily, we are able to share it now! I was - and am - so very proud of this amazing team of people & especially of your children whose learning behaviours and attitudes were a credit to you all.

It came as little surprise to us, then, when we discovered exactly how well our year 6 pupils had performed in their end of year examinations. They made astronomical progress and ended up with scores that were amongst the best in the country - in maths, for example, Stebon came in the top 2% nationally, and reading and writing weren't far behind. The pupils' academic performance was a reflection not just of the teaching they received in Y6, but of the provision throughout all of their schooling with us. They left Stebon as well-rounded, successful young people, ready for the next stage in their education. This year's Y6 have a hard act to follow & they're making good headway already.

Next term, we're making some changes to lunchtimes, including introducing new games in different zones in the playground, facilitated by the adults there. We hope the changes will mean that the children enjoy their lunchtimes even more & get the most out of them. We've made a short video explaining some of the changes. You can see it here.

All that remains is for me to wish you all the happiest of holidays. It's a great time to rest & recover ... and to read!

Look after yourselves & one another and we'll see you back here smiling in 2024.




