They are using some new software called 'Crumble' to learn about coding and how computers can be used to program robots and machines. Here they are working together to change colours on a light!



As part of literacy this week, Reception have been making their own giants by drawing around their friends. They have also been talking about story settings. They explored the settings in Jack and the Beanstalk. They drew what settings they could see at the top and the bottom of the beanstalk.

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Thank you to all the parents who came to our **Reception** Maths workshop on Monday!




Come along to our **Coffee Morning** on **Thursday 1st Feb** for a painting on canvas board session facilitated by Helen.




In Art Club, pupils were reproducing the most famous painting from Salvador Dali, The persistence of Memory 1931.


