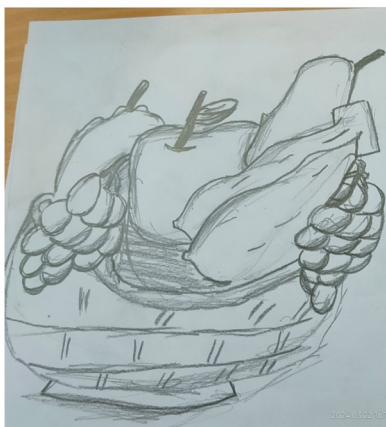


Tafida (Y5 Martin Luther King class) took part in a performance at Marner school last week to celebrate World Down Syndrome Day.
