

ESOL Initial Assessment Morning

Monday 14th October, 10am - 1pm in the Family Learning Room

For Adults who would like to learn English.

There are different levels of ability for ESOL, therefore it is important to be assessed, so that learners join the correct level.

The course will be free if you meet the following criteria:

- 1. U.K. resident, has been here for three years,
 - 2. Has a National Insurance number
- 3. On income (no more than £23,000 and/or in receipt of benefits).

To attend the Initial Assessment morning, you will need to bring the following proof of ID and income:

- 1. Some form of photo ID: (passport or driving licence)
- 2. Proof of address: (Council Tax (within 12 months) bank/credit card statement, utility bill (within last 3 months)
- 3. Proof of income: Universal Credit/benefit proof (no longer than 12 months and clearly states your name/date)


Half Term Crafterschool
