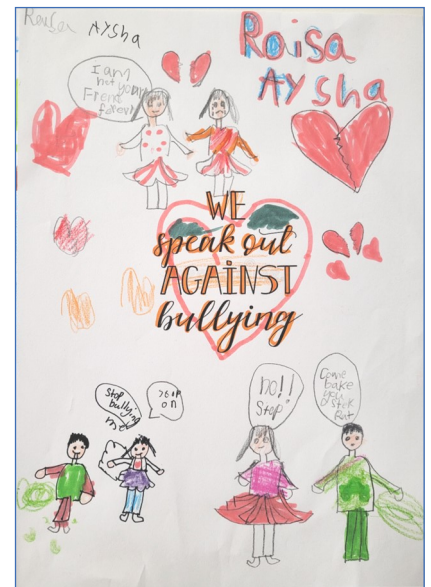
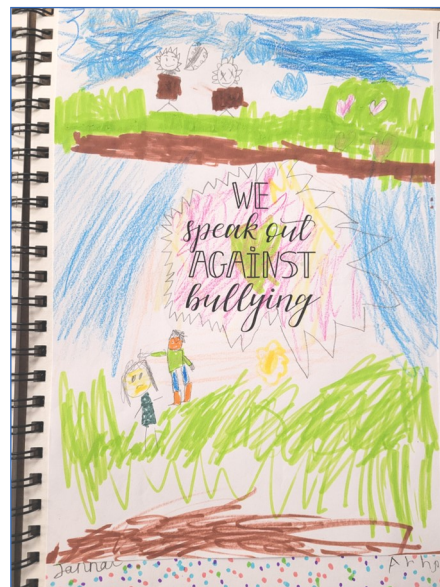
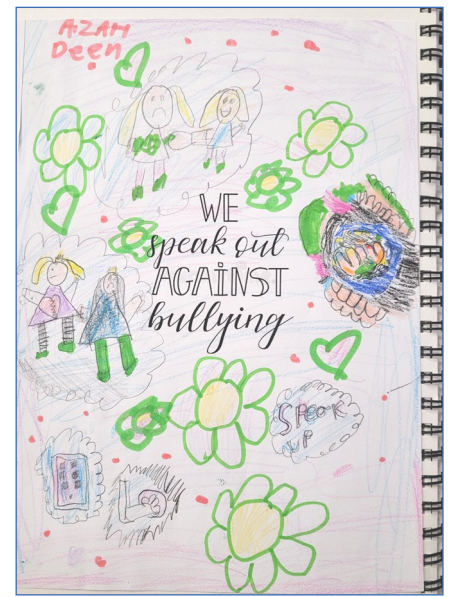
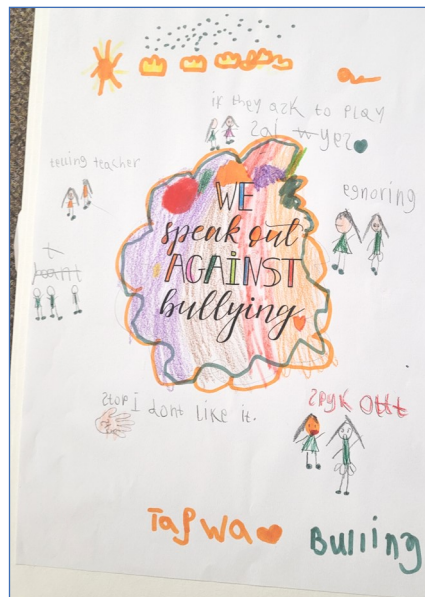
Friendship & Anti-bullying week: Monday 11 - Friday 15 November 2024

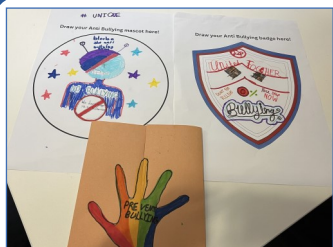

We are fundraising for NSPCC this year, **we raised £76 just by donating and wearing our odd socks to school! Thank you for your donations**

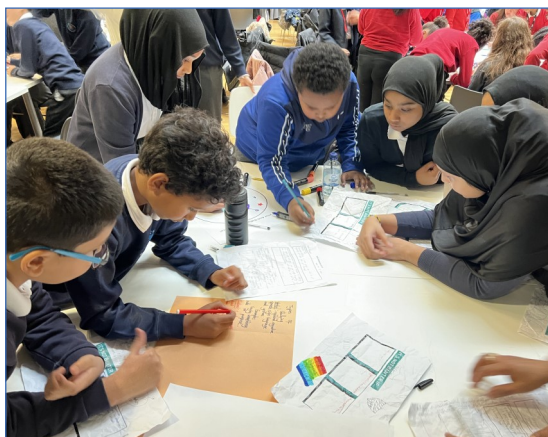

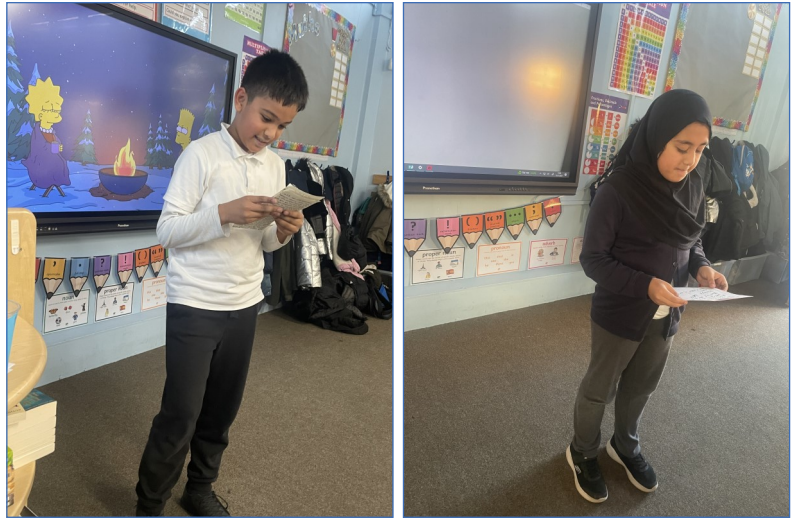
In Art club, the children enthusiastically incorporated the manga style while creating their characters!

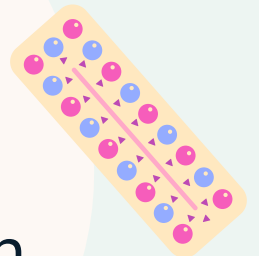
