There are a few different ways that we will be celebrating World Book Day.

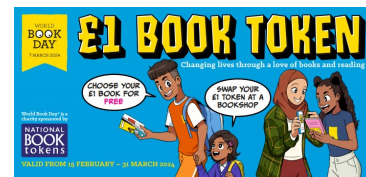
We are encouraging children to create costumes at home and come to school dressed up as a character from a book. We'll be having our annual runway show in school, with prizes awarded in each phase.

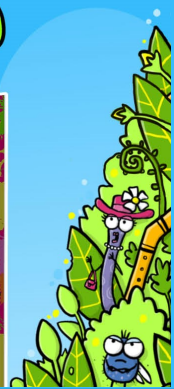
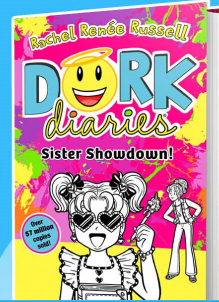
We can't wait to see the costumes the children create!
