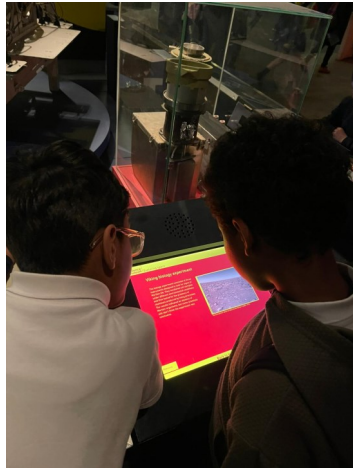

We are pleased to announce Dr Enamul Omam has joined [our local governing board](#) as a parent governor.

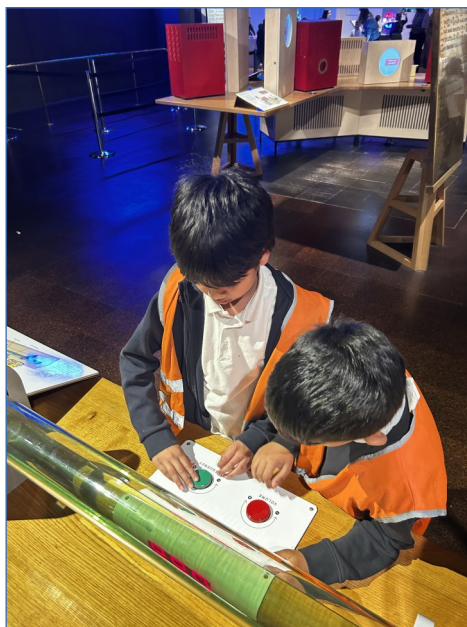

Year 5: Equality Now (promoting equal rights for women and girls worldwide)

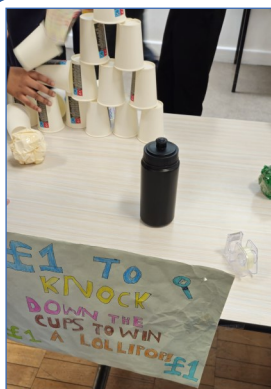
Year 6: Show Racism the Red Card (tackling racism through education)

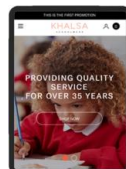

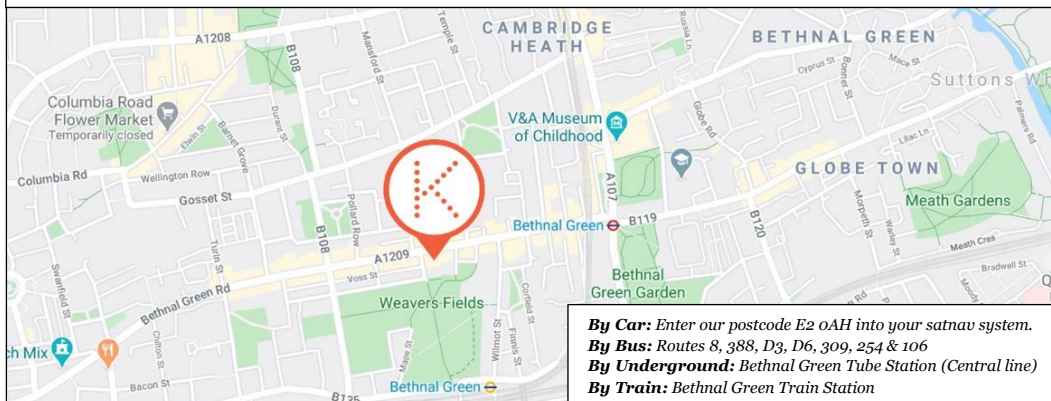
