Next week, you will receive an email with a link to the booking system for your child's class.

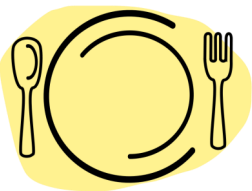
We took our sibling photos today!

There's still time to bring in donations on Monday!

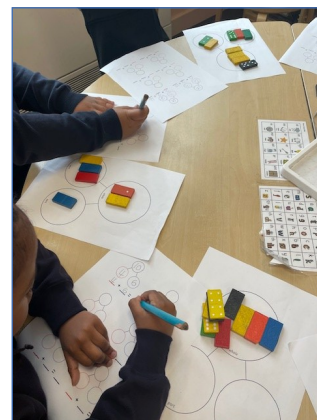


YR AS class
