Come on Stebon!

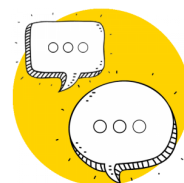
Parent Oracy Survey

What is oracy?

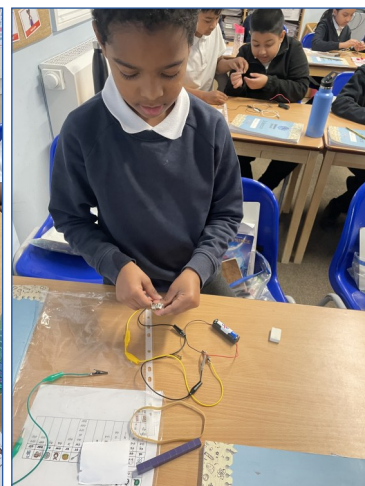
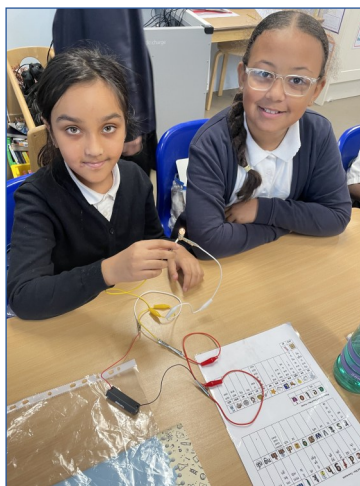
Oracy is the ability to articulate ideas, develop understanding and engage with others through spoken language, listening and communication. (Oracy Education Commission, 2024)

By completing [this survey](#), you will help us to understand how we can best support children's speaking, listening, and communication skills.

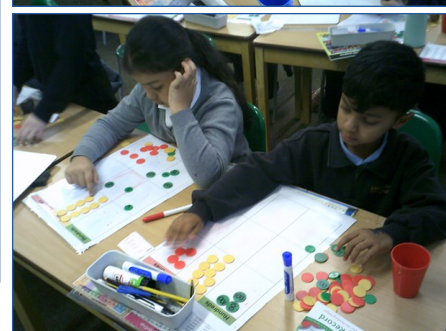


Year 4 have enjoyed exploring electrical circuits - predicting whether materials are conductors or insulators, and then putting their ideas to the test!

We're now eagerly looking forward to our exciting visit to the Science Museum's Wonderlab next week!



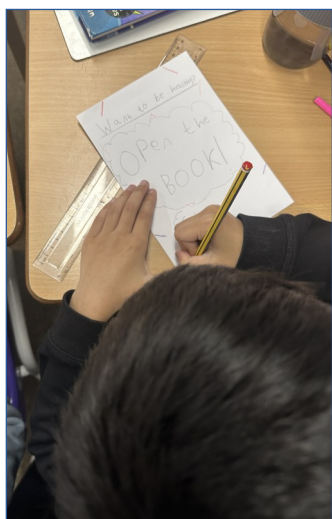
Y3 Beethoven class have been learning how to exchange ones and tens in maths this week, which they thoroughly enjoyed.
