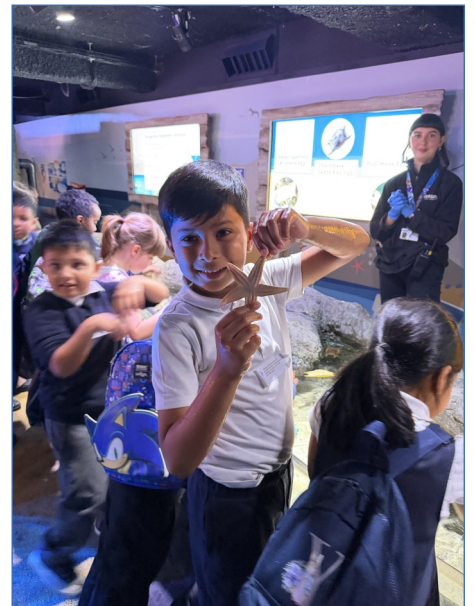
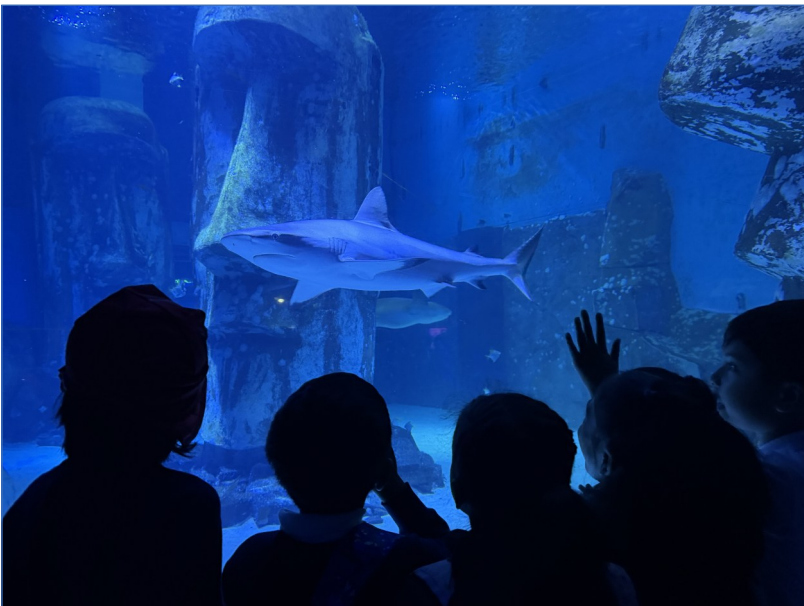

If you are a parent or carer for a child at Stebon, we would really love to hear what you think about the job we're doing. This is so that we know the things to keep doing and where we need to make improvements.



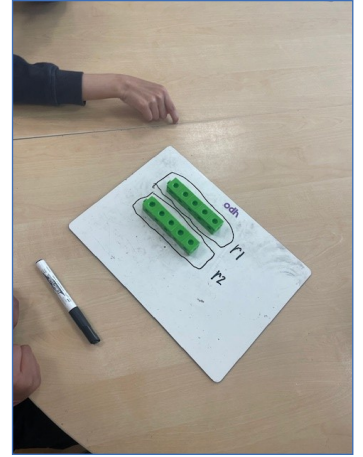
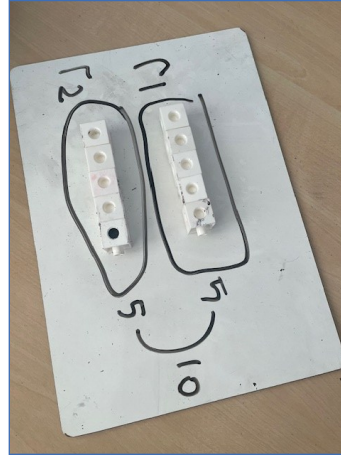
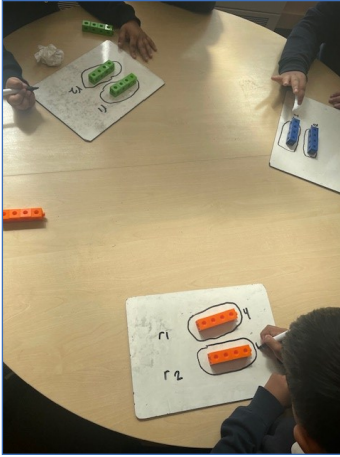
Year 2 visited the Sea Life Aquarium to support our learning in Science and English!



Reception went pond dipping at the Soanes Centre this week! They learned about changes and lifecycles of animals found in the ponds.



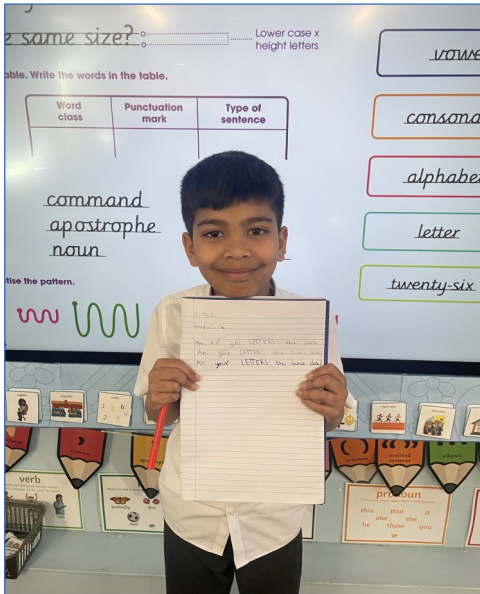
Year 1 Margot Fonteyn class have been learning about arrays to help us understand multiplication. We started with doubling and will move on to represent other multiplication facts soon.

Our topic this term in year 1 is: we love London. We have been learning about London landmarks and painted these skyline views of some of London's most recognised landmarks. How many of them can you name?

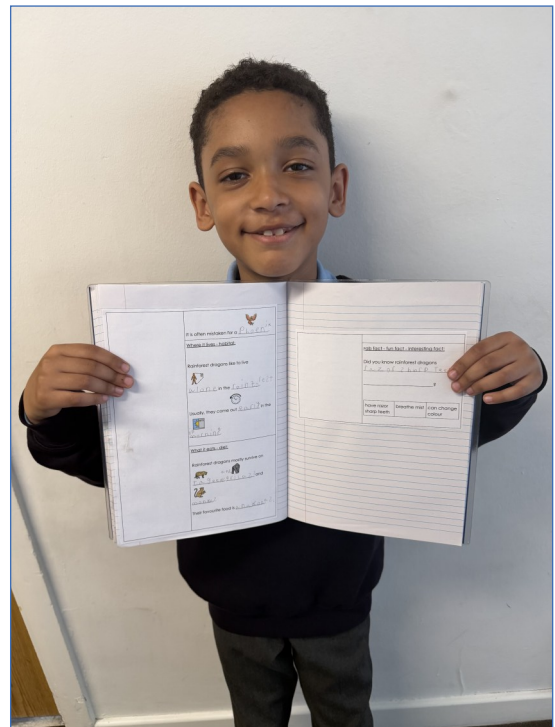

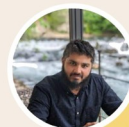
